Page 1 of 2: OFFER OF TERMS

Provider and the Subscribing LEA (named below) agree by signing this General Offer of Privacy Terms ("General Offer") that they are bound by the same terms as the DPA between Provider and Tooele County School District ("Originating LEA") dated 1/5/2026.

Provider and Subscribing LEA agree that the information below will be replaced throughout the DPA with the information specific to the Subscribing LEA filled in below for the Subscribing LEA. This General Offer shall extend only to the terms set forth in this DPA and shall not necessarily bind Provider or Subscribing LEA to any other terms entered into between Provider and Originating LEA. Any commercial terms, such as price, term, or schedule of Services, relating to Subscribing LEA's use of the Provider's Services shall be determined solely between Provider and Subscribing LEA.

If Provider makes changes to Exhibit "A" or Exhibit "B" in accordance with sections 1.2 and 1.3 respectively, Provider must complete the Addendum template provided by the A4L Community and notify the Originating LEA and all Subscribing LEAs in accordance with the notification provisions of this DPA, of the Addendum's existence and contents. With regard to a Subscribing LEA, an Addendum is automatically incorporated into this DPA when Subscribing LEA is notified by Provider. If an Addendum modifies Exhibit "B", the LEA will have thirty (30) days from receipt to object. If no written objection is received it will become incorporated into the DPA between the parties.

The Provider may withdraw the General Offer (for future use or for LEAs that have not already accepted it) in the event of: (1) a material change in the applicable privacy statutes; or (2) a material change in the Services and products listed in the Service Agreement. Keys to Success, a program of Ken Garff for Good, motivates students and adults across Utah to unlock their future by connecting them with scholarships, internships, and opportunities that match their career interests. The Keys to Success program has always been a student and user-first initiative. As of 2020, the Keys to Success platform is utilized statewide as a College and Career Readiness tool that provides resources for individuals on their own personal path to success.

Students are rewarded and incentivized for their progress towards college and career readiness by earning points for completing various activities (applying for scholarships or internships, taking career assessments, completing FAFSA, etc.) These points may be redeemed for prizes through the app.

The Keys to Success app also hosts a number of resources for students, including:

- The ability to select school-specific CTE pathways
- Access to career and aptitude assessments through YouScience
- FAFSA tutorials
- Information regarding grants, student loans, work-study programs, 529 college savings plans, state scholarships and over \$160 million in private and public scholarships available to students
- Step by step ACT Prep and College Planning tools
- Utah College Application Week platform, partnered with Utah System of Higher Education (USHE) and all public higher education institutions in Utah
- Lists of resources for undocumented Utah students
- Counselor Planning Guide: Scope and Sequence resources: worksheets, course curriculum, etc.
- Content to align with and support the College and Career Awareness course for all 7th grade Utah students

The Keys to Success app asks the following required survey questions to student users:

- Select your top 5 career choices
- Select desired CTE Pathways for this school year
- Select colleges of interest
- Have you toured [specific Utah college or university] campus?
- Have you applied to [specific Utah college or university]?
- Have you submitted your FAFSA form?

The Keys to Success program and app also includes a portal for adult users, with the following tracks available: Post-Secondary Ready, Skill Up, Career Exploration, and Job Search. Local skill training and certificate information is hosted in-app, along with job postings via an API with the Department of Workforce Services. Keys to Success is Utah's one-stop shop for college and career readiness, from 7th grade through retirement.

Road to Success, a program of Ken Garff for Good, seeks to improve the literacy skills of K-6 grade students through incentivized daily reading tracking. Students are given milestones of reading minutes to hit in their tracking and upon hitting each milestone, teachers have the responsibility to reward students with small toys or vouchers as prizes. All prizes are provided by Road to Success at the beginning of the school year and teachers maintain the school's prize inventory throughout the school year. Parents can sign into their student's account using their SSO but do not have accounts of their own, so no parents data is required in order for students to participate.

As of 2021, Road to Success utilizes the platform Beanstack to track and reward students for their reading minutes. The platform enables students to do the following:

- Join reading challenges created by Beanstack or created by teachers at their assigned school
- Track reading minutes by parents logging in to a website or app
- Rate books after completing them

The platform requires or uses the following student data:

- Student first and last name
- Student single sign in information to school's rostering system such as Clever, Classlink or Google SSO (usually schools who do this use Clever for their rostering)
- Student assigned teacher and grade
- Total reading minutes and prizes redeemed from teacher reporting per classroom

Ken Garff Esports, a program of Ken Garff for Good, enhances and enriches scholastic experiences through and beyond gaming. Students are given unique opportunities to compete in esports events designed to help students explore college and career opportunities after high school.

Ken Garff Esports does this by:

- Creating meaningful opportunities for students to connect to CTE pathways, especially in the Computer Science, Information Technology, and Digital Media industries.
- Supporting educator and local education agencies in Utah with resources to be able to participate equitably in these opportunities.

The following information asked of students is for the purpose of ensuring competitive integrity, identifying school representation, and ensuring each equitable opportunities.

- Student school
- Student in-game/app usernames
- Student age
- Student survey responses
