Any information NewsBank receives from customers will never be sold to a third party for marketing purposes.

In lieu of signing customer's individually drafted privacy statements/agreements, this letter is to confirm that NewsBank will comply with all state privacy laws, including N.Y. Educ. Law § 2-d, and all federal privacy laws, as such laws are applicable to NewsBank and its operations.
